Also known as "Court Dolls", these chubby, white-skinned, baby dolls were given as gifts to aristocrats for hundreds of years. They are thought to bring good luck, prosperity, and happiness. Goshō Ningyō would be passed down to the next generation as part of a family member's art collection.
