



Japanese Six Panel Screen: The Burning of Nanto Temple (A Scene from the 12th Century Heike Wars)

Ruler Taira Shigehira ordered an attack on those who opposed his rule. During the battle, Nanto Temple, in Nara, was burned to the ground.
