Real name: Aoki Keinosuke (1891 - 1973), born in Kyoto, studied Shijo school of painting under Takeuchi Seiho. Graduated from Kyoto Bijutsu Kogei Gakkou and Kyoto Kaiga Senmon Gakkou. Exhibited at Teiten 7,8,9,11,14,15; Shinbunten 2, 3, 6; Nitten 4, 13. Lacquer framed individual panels with cotton webbing hinges (as pictured).
